ATTENDANCE AND PARTICIPATION CONTRACT

Student Agreement:

I understand that membership in the CCCC is a privilege and will contribute to its success by doing the following:

- Attending all rehearsals in a punctual manner. Less than 90% attendance may affect eligibility to perform at concerts or attend CCCC special events. Performance at any special event will be dependent not only on attendance, but knowledge of music and classroom participation conduct. Please notify your director as quickly as possible of any conflicts with scheduled rehearsals.
- Planning to be at every performance and special event at the designated call time. Tardiness beyond 10 minutes may affect performance status at that event.
- Listening & participating attentively in rehearsals.
- Showing kindness and respect to other CCCC members and directors.
- Demonstrating good etiquette at performances and special events by following directions of director and parent volunteers, listening with respect to other performers, and planning to stay for the entire event when necessary.
- Keeping updated on special events and information by watching for emails from the CCCC and relaying announcements given during rehearsal.
- Committing to the CCCC for the entire season.
- Arranging rides to and from all rehearsals and performances.
- **NEW MEMBERS OF THE CCCC:** Many special performances we participate in limit the number of singers that are asked to perform. In such circumstances priority is given to long-standing members and then members who have demonstrated excellent musicianship, punctuality, focus, and attendance. The more you show your director you are capable of being a professional musician, the more she will ask you to perform as one.
